## Integrate Non-MEDITECH Applications with EMR


Is your EMR module missing important patient data from non-MEDITECH systems? Do you avoid using non-MEDITECH systems because clinical information will not show up in EMR? If either answer is "yes", **C/S Link** can resolve those issues.

**C/S Link** is designed to provide a more complete EMR to your clinicians by seamlessly linking EMR with non-MEDITECH systems, including:

- ✓ Any external executable program (for example, PACS viewing)
- ✓ Iatric applications
- ✓ Any specific web site url
- ✓ Other MEDITECH marketplace third party vendor systems (for example, Array and MSM/Picis)

**C/S Link** launches applications from icons located at the top of your EMR screen (see screenshot below), and brings clinicians directly into those applications with the patient already identified, eliminating extra keystrokes.

The user's EMR session continues to stay active even after clicking on the link, so clinicians can view patient data in non-MEDITECH applications and EMR simultaneously.
